Dance Class

Dance class is a valuable aspect of our curriculum. Lessons take place in the Daisy Room in a purpose-built Studio Hall. As your child becomes more confident, grade work continues with the R.A.D. Syllabus with Grade Exams.

The Teddy Bear Award involves mime, dance and song. The children receive a plaque, badge and certificate.

During dance class, the children will need the following:

Girls - one ballet bag, a pink leotard, pink skirt, pink socks, pink headband and pink ballet shoes.

Boys - One bag, white T-shirt, black shorts, white ankle socks and black ballet shoes.

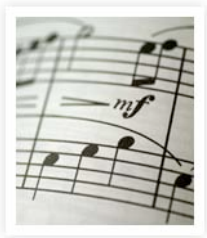
Dance clothing can be purchased within nursery.

Music

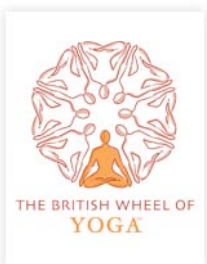
Providing an opportunity for young children to learn to read and play music. A superb learning opportunity for your child, the tuition will prepare the children for more formal tuition later on and will give much-needed grounding in basic music skills, such as rhythm and notation.
